



ARTICLE XII NOMINATING and ELECTION COMMITTEE

Section 1. Forming a Nominating Committee

(A) At the September Board Meeting, the Board will appoint two members, in good standing, as defined in (Article VI, Section 7) to the Nominating and Election Committee.

- (B) At the October General Meeting, three (3) additional members will be added to Nominating Committee. These additional members will be added from the floor. In the event, there are more than three (3) seeking to become committee members, an open vote by the attending members, providing a quorum is present, will settle the issue.
- (C) At another time, this committee will choose their chairperson. This committee is then charged with the responsibility of seeking a slate of officers, to present for election. The selected slate shall be presented to The Board at their October meeting and then to the membership in the General Meeting in November.
- (D) At the November General Meeting any final nominees from the floor may declare their candidacy.
- (E) All candidates for office should make their intentions, known to the Nominating and election Committee <u>before</u> the <u>October Board Meeting</u> so the candidate's qualifications can be reviewed. Any late nominees from the floor will have their credentials checked in the weeks between the November General Meeting and December's election.
- (F) All members of a Nominating committee are not barred from becoming nominees for office themselves. in any election where they serve on said Committee.
- (G) The election will be held at the December General Meeting and shall be held by secret ballot, in the Columbus Room.
- (H) The Chairperson of the Nominating and Election Committee shall enlist any number of members required to assist the Chair in the election proceedings.
- All <u>eligible</u> members can vote, provided they have been members for 120 days.
- (J) Successful candidates shall be determined by a majority of the votes cast.
- (K) The Installation of the newly elected officers will be conducted at the January General Meeting. The Chairperson of the Nominating and Election Committee will officiate at the proceedings.

Section 2. Nominations and Election

- (A) To be nominated for an office and run for an office, a member must be qualified as defined under Article IV, Section 3.
- (B) In the case of a tie vote, and after a proper recount, the membership shall be asked to vote again. The second vote, also a secret ballot, will also be cast in the Columbus Room. In the unlikely event, there is still a tie, after two votes and two recounts; a separate, special election will be scheduled by the Board. The date time and place shall be set, by The Board, while the members are still present at the December General Meeting.
- (C) All outgoing officers must convey to the successful candidate all papers and documents concerning their office. Such materials are Club property and must be conveyed prior the Installation of Officers.
- (D) Installation of the newly elected Board will be effected at the General Meeting following the election (see Article XII Section1(K)).

NOTE: Article X—Section 5. To vote in a General Election or on By-Laws, you must be a member "in good standing." See definitions.

- *** (1) <u>Members in Good Standing</u> Any members, current in their dues, having been a member for at least a year, and attended at least half of the current year's meetings, and with no charges (grievances) or convictions on his/her record, is considered in Good Standing.
- (2) <u>Sign in Book</u> All <u>members must sign</u> attendance sheets or the "sign in book" for the purpose of recording qualifications and/or attendance that may be required for functions, events, or to further define "good standing" requirements.
